HOW TO APPLY FOR MEDICAID

Apply online at www.yourtexasbenefits.com, you may also contact 211 or 817-541-7905 and staff can assist you Monday through Friday 8am to 6 pm



THINGS TO CONSIDER FOR YOUR 1ST PRENATAL APPOINTMENT

Bring your current prenatal vitamins to your 1st appointment. Your doctor will assess if you need anything more.

Bring any current vaccine and/or medical records you may have to your first visit.

It is important for you to schedule an appointment as soon as you have your temporary Medicaid ID number. (Even if you don't have your card yet)

It usually takes 4-6 weeks to receive your medicaid card in the mail.

COMPLETE THE APPLICATION



Take a picture of the Report of Pregnancy Form & upload to application



Upload the following additional documents:

- 1.) Previous income tax form
- 2.) Government approved identification
- 3.) Proof of income
- 4.) Proof of residency
- 5.) Total value of cars & property



Look for confirmation number when application is complete. Check back on the status of the application until it says: APPROVED. (may take a few days)



Call the Medicaid office once you have APPROVED status. Ask for your temporary ID number so you can start prenatal care with a doctor.

MISCARRIAGE & ECTOPIC PRECAUTIONS

GO TO THE ER FOR:

A Miscarriage is the loss of an unborn baby before 20 weeks.

An Ectopic Pregnancy (tubal pregnancy) is a pregnancy that is not within the uterus.

Symptoms of Miscarriage or Ectopic pregnancy may include:

Heavy bleeding.

Cramping pain in your pelvis, lower back, or lower abdomen.

Pain that occurs on one side of your abdomen.

A gush of warm fluid or passage of tissue from your vagina.

Lightheadedness, dizziness, or blackouts.

Abnormally low blood pressure.

If you suspect you are having a miscarriage or an ectopic pregnancy, call your doctor immediately. If you do not have a doctor yet, go directly to the nearest Emergency Room.

Vaginal bleeding (enough to fill a pad in 24 hrs)

Abdominal Cramping (pain level 6 or greater)

Temperature of 100.4 or greater

Unable to keep down clear liquids for 24 hours

Repeated tightening of the uterus, getting longer, stronger & closer together

Fluid from the vagina that isn't urine or normal pregnancy discharge

Severe sore throat

Headache so severe you can't do your normal daily activities

Sudden & severe swelling of the face and/or hands

28 weeks or greater and have not felt 10 or more movements by the baby in 24 hours
